


Technology is no longer a tool,








WIKIPEDIA: CREDIBLE SOURCE?

Apollo 13 was the seventh manned mission in the American Apollo space program and the was launched on April 11, 1970, at 13:13 CST from the Kennedy Space Center, Florida, be tank exploded two days later, crippling the Service Module (SM) upon which the Comman caused by limited power, loss of cabin heat, shortage of potable water, and the critical need the crew returned safely to Earth on April 17.

The flight was commanded by James A. Lovell with John L. "Jack" Swigert as Command I Pilot. Swigert was a late replacement for the original CM pilot Ken Mattingly, who was ground German measles.


